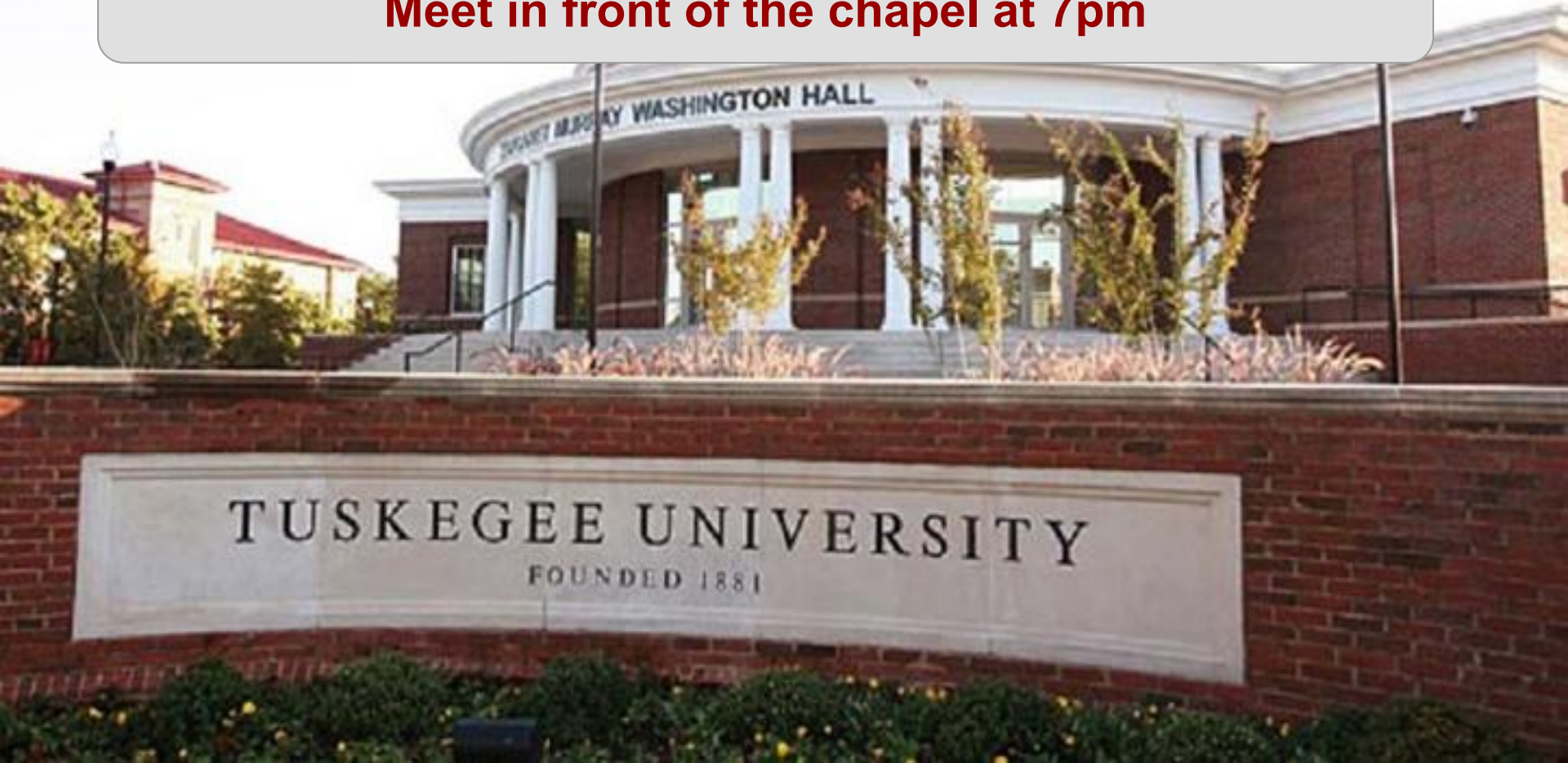

Popular teaching about being Led by the Holy Spirit:

Once the Spirit comes into your hearts, we have an automatic guidance system that enables God to lead us through life and its maze of decisions, like having a spiritual GPS.





Romans 8:12-15

¹² Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation—but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. ¹³ For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

¹⁴ For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. ¹⁵ The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, “Abba, Father.”

Galatians 5:16-20

¹⁶ So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. Being led by the Spirit means putting to death our sinful nature!

The Spirit leads us in God's moral will, not his mystical will for every detail of our lives!

This means that most decisions in our lives will need to be made without divine direction. All the more, we need prayer, seeking advice and careful weighing of biblical principles!

Counselor: paraklétos - an advocate, intercessor, helper, comforter,

Convict: elegchó: reprove, rebuke, discipline, expose, show to be guilty.

**The main purpose of the Holy Spirit
is to convict us of sin!**

**Are you allowing the Holy Spirit to
lead you by convicting you
of sin?**

It is not biblical terminology to say:

- “The Spirit put it on my heart to be alone.”
- “The Spirit led me to go to Taco Bell today.”
- “The Spirit showed me that I need to take this job even though it prevents me from being committed to the church.”
- “The Spirit told me that I need some time away from church.”

What we should be saying (but unfortunately you don't hear this much):

- “The Spirit helped me to overcome my lust.”
- “The Spirit helped me to be convicted by that scripture to show me I need to be more loving.”
- “The Spirit is showing me that my feelings are not correct.”
- “The Spirit allowed me to be rebuked so I would change this ongoing sin.”
- “The Spirit is allowing me to go through this hardship so that I can become more like Jesus.”

- The central activity of the Spirit is convicting us of sin and enabling us to overcome it.

Summary: Spirit Led

- The Spirit does not lead us through our feelings, promptings or mystical revelation.
- The central activity of the Spirit is convicting us of sin and enabling us to overcome it.
- Being led by the Holy Spirit does not mean that we no longer make our own decisions but we need to:
 - **Seek advice** - The Spirit leads us through men and women who are mature in the Word.
 - **Pray** - can move mountains!
 - **Study scripture to find direction** - God's Spirit leads us through the principles of the Word.
